If you can't remember the tune, then say it with a beat. Repeat the verse 2-3 times.

Point to the dots as you say the numbers.

Toddlers will let you know when they know the verse. [Remember testing or showing others what the child can do may turn off the child's desire to learn.]

- The child will start anticipating the words and motions when they begin to learn it.
- If you stop before the end of the line and the child finishes the line, then you know they have learned it.
- When you hear the child singing or saying the verse while they are playing or riding in the car. Say...

"I heard you say/sing 1 Corinthians 10:31 **You are a good learner**!"

You can also substitute other things the child does like this: Whether you brush your teeth, Or pick up your toys, Do it all for the glory of God.
